John Wilkerson was named President-elect of Olive Garden on June 18, 2025, and will become President on September 1, 2025, following the retirement of current President Dan Kiernan.

Previously, John served as President of Cheddar's Scratch Kitchen for seven years, where he successfully led the effort to rebuild the brand's operating fundamentals and set it up for growth.

Prior to Cheddar's, he served as President of Bahama Breeze, where he developed and executed against a strategic plan that continuously delivered same-restaurant sales growth, improved the guest experience and transformed the Bahama Breeze culture.

He transitioned to the Restaurant Support Center six years later as Sr. Financial Analyst for Red Lobster.
