She also served as an advisor on key regulatory areas — including Data Privacy, Anti-Trust, HR Compliance, Anti-Corruption and FCPA, and Food and Drug Administration matters — and oversaw compliance and ethics investigations.

Prior to Darden, Lindsay served as Assistant General Counsel for Walmart, where she served as a subject matter expert on international compliance matters in 26 countries across Asia, Latin America, Africa, and the United Kingdom. She also previously held roles as an Attorney at Dinsmore & Shohl and as an Attorney for the U.S. Department of Justice.
